

Trees		
Vine Maple	<i>Acer circinatum</i>	Brilliant fall color from gold to scarlet often occurring at the same time on the same tree with still green foliage
Big Leaf Maple	<i>Acer macrophyllum</i>	Bright gold fall foliage
Pacific Madrone	<i>Arbutus menziesii</i>	Smooth, red-brown, often peeling bark, evergreen
Hawthorne	<i>Crataegus douglasii</i> (<i>suksdorfii</i>)	Bright gold to orange fall foliage and clusters of scarlet berries that persist into winter, attracts birds

Shrubs		
Serviceberry	<i>Amelanchier alnifolia</i>	Golden, orange fall color
Red Osier Dogwood	<i>Cornus sericea</i>	Foliage transitions from golden through deep red to maroon, bright red twigs create an exciting winter visual treat
Twinberry	<i>Lonicera involucrata</i>	Bright golden to yellow fall foliage and clusters of purple fruit which can persist into winter, attracts birds
Oregon Grape species	<i>Mahonia aquifolium</i> , <i>M. nervosa</i>	Some leaves turn scarlet red to wine red
Rose species	<i>Rosa nutkana</i> , <i>R. pisocarpa</i>	Persistent coral to scarlet rose hips, pairs well with snowberry
Snowberry	<i>Symphoricarpos albus</i>	Persistent clusters of glowing white berries, winter interest, pairs well with <i>Rosa</i> spp.
Evergreen huckleberry	<i>Vaccinium ovatum</i>	Bright red to orange fall color with clusters of deep purple berries, attracts birds

Groundcovers		
Goat's Beard	<i>Aruncus dioicus</i>	Golden fall foliage with dangling contrasting black seed heads
Bunchberry	<i>Cornus</i>	Red wine fall foliage
False Solomon's Seal	<i>Maianthemum racemosum</i>	Golden fall foliage with persistent clusters of scarlet berries
